



AB13 (VACA ACT) Non-Resident Tuition Fee Waiver

Effective July 1, 2015, *California Education Code (68075.5(c)c)* allows California Community Colleges to grant full exemption from the nonresident fee for all students verified to be "covered individuals" per the below criteria **and** that qualify to use Montgomery GI Bill-Active Duty or Post-9/11 GI Bill education benefits (Chapters 30 and 33, respectively, of Title 38, U.S. Code) while living in California. Senate Bill (SB) 701 amended the current *California Education Code (CEC) 68075.7* to conform with the federal law that eliminated the requirement of the expiration of a 3-year eligibility period. Beginning August 1, 2022, students eligible to qualify for the Survivors' and Dependents Educational Assistance Program (Chapter 35 of Title 38, U.S. Code) will also be considered as "covered individuals" under the Colonel John M. McHugh Tuition Fairness for Survivors Act of 2021.
